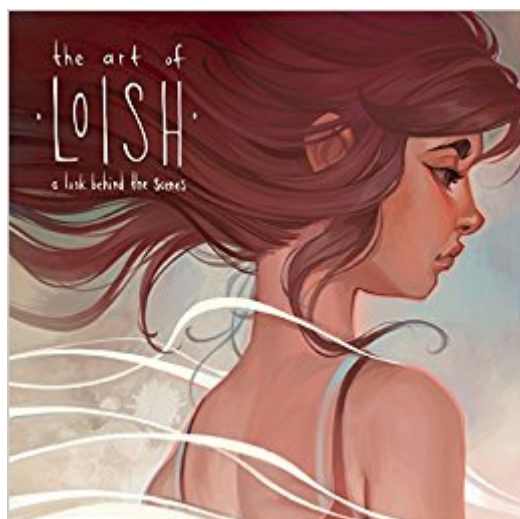

Well This book is the perfect pick-me-up. She explains her thoughts, work flow, and what it takes to get things done. This book does not just show you pretty pictures. There is just some art missing from the book that I would have loved to have included in it (example: her work titled "surfacing" was missing from the book and would have really loved to have had that in the book and how it was done). It is apparent that a great deal of thoughtful consideration went into the production of this uniquely remarkable book. I received it for supporting the Loish Kickstarter project. This isn't your typical "art of" book in that it offers not only a beautiful representative sampling of her significant body of work, but it also presents these creative pieces and related commentary in such a unique way as to give the reader a clear sense of the creative person behind it. And that's a good thing. As an artist and art book collector, I've found far too many books of this type that simply provide intriguing "eye candy" (which is fine) but little in the way of offering the reader a compelling, approachable or meaningful view of the process, intent, circumstances or feelings that gave rise to their artwork. This book is solid, well bound and its pages are of a pleasing matte finish that gives each image a sort of surreal quality which is complementary to Loish's style in general. While I always want more, I have to say that the number of pages offered is pretty much right on target for the tone of its content if that makes sense. Beautifully rendered completed art pieces as well as preliminary sketches and studies are well interspersed through sections of the book as are a good number of engaging comparative reinterpretations of her earlier works. Throughout this book, Lois van Baarle has a very relatable conversation, if you will, with the reader that gives one the sense that she is not only a professional who cares about her work and the creative process, but is humbly driven to make beautiful things for all to admire and explore. That's really cool and so is this book!

I'm always skeptical when I buy art books because I'm afraid that it won't be helpful and I wouldn't learn anything from it. But not only did I learn a thing or two from loish's book, I get inspired by her art in it. This is strangely the first book I had with a tutorial or tutorials in it. So I'm happy about that because for me it really hard to find tips and tutorials for Photoshop. So I'm really glad I got it before it ran out of stock. I recommend getting it.

It is an awesome book! I will be purchasing another copy for my sister who is going to college for graphic design. It's very informative into the artist creative process and skill development. Recommend for any artist.
