

IT does read a little bit dry, but I'm not sure how much more

exciting you can get with law, legalities, procedures and such. Good information.

This book (purchased as a text for a graduate level planning class) provides a thorough but relatively superficial guide to creating development plans in a rural context. Although those completely new to community planning or rural areas may find it helpful, as someone who is familiar with both I did not particularly enjoy this book.
