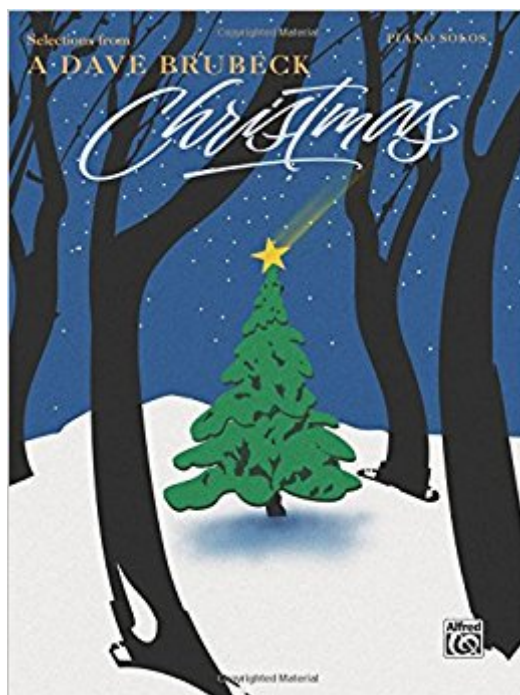

I'd put the pieces in this book right behind the Charlie Brown Christmas music (by Vince Guaraldi) as far as the best jazz piano pieces for the holidays. The level of difficulty is similar to that of Charlie Brown, and the pieces have a very similar feel with a different 'Brubeck' sort of flavor. If you'd like to add a bit of variety to your Christmas repertoire (either for your job at the restaurant/lobby or family parties), I'd highly recommend this book.

You can easily figure out for yourself if this book will suit your taste and piano skills before buying it. Dave has recorded all these songs and you can listen to samples here. As you'll note, this book contains nine "selections" of scores from that 14-song album. The five songs that are on the recording but not in the book are: Santa Claus Is Coming to Town; O Little Town of Bethlehem; Run, Run to Bethlehem; "Farewell" Jingle Bells and The Christmas Song.

It isn't Christmas in my house until we turn on the Dave Brubeck CD. For as long as I can remember, we've decorated the tree to the swinging syncopations of Jingle Bells, the flowing melodies of Joy to the World. So, this Christmas, when my parents bought me this book, I was absolutely thrilled. Dave Brubeck's passion for his music shows through in every note, resulting in an inspired, fun, emotional, and beautiful work. I've played piano for about eight years and the only songs I had any real trouble with were Walking in a Winter Wonderland and What Child is This, due to some (for me) very long reaches and complicated chords. Other than that, I had so much fun playing these creative and well-arranged pieces. I would highly recommend this book to any advanced piano player.
